

'Indonesia across Orders:

The reorganization of Indonesian society' has been developed at the request of the Dutch Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport. The research is aimed at providing new insights into the consequences of war, revolution, and decolonization for the different population groups in the Indonesian archipelago from the 1930s to the 1960s.

The programme covers four research areas that embrace a wide range of social developments: the Indonesianisasi of the economy and of the world of industry and commerce; the financial settlement and the question of war damage, rehabilitation and repayment; the mechanisms of and views on order and security; and the changes in urban society.
